Breadfruit Varieties | Ma'afala

NOTES: A shorter, more compact tree than other varieties. Small-fruited. The creamy to pale-yellow flesh is not as dense or firm as typical Polynesian varieties and exhibits a tender texture when cooked.

Skin Texture: Slightly rough, irregularly raised, flattened to sandpaper

Seeds: Generally seedless, occasionally one or more seed per fruit
